## Independent Mental Health Network Updates

1. Over the year the IMHN has been recording Service user and Carers videos of their experiences of using Mental Health services which have then been played to commissioners and service providers giving lived experience of using mental health services.

2. Serious Mental illness and Physical Health Checks – The IMHN has been involved with looking to improve the take up for people with an SMI which was very low at the start of year in Surrey Heartlands and has now achieved NHS England target of 60%.

3. The IMHN has been involved in the Mental Health Improvement Plan – Looking to reduce the amount of bouncing around the mental health system. We formed a Focus group and that is ongoing looking at ways to reduce this going forward.

4. There was also the Community Connections tender 2024 where the IMHN took part in the procurement questions, evaluation and moderation.



### **Good News Story**

An outreach support worker recently contacted the IMHN to say he had a client's story that he wanted to be told and so we recorded a video. John (not his real name) was recently supported through the Bridge the Gap service in Surrey which aims to help people with multiple disadvantages (homelessness, drug and alcohol addiction and poor mental health), He was suffering with drug and alcohol problems, nowhere to live and feeling very low in mood.

John met with a Bridge the Gap outreach worker who was able to discuss his situation and offer some support. Initially John was reluctant and didn't know whether to believe him, but the outreach worker persisted and John learnt to trust him and he helped him to go to support meetings for drug and alcohol misuse. By being the contact point for John the outreach worker was able to help with Benefits as well and helping to find somewhere to live.

John now has accommodation and is planning to spend his Christmas with his family and this wouldn't have been possible without this truly life changing support service.
